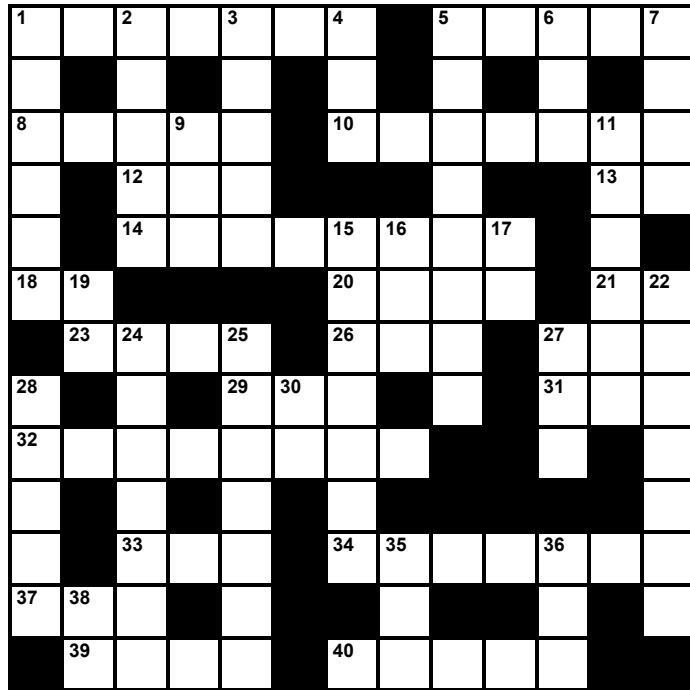


Crossword by Myles Mellor
